THREDBO MOUNTAIN TOURS
Presented by Toyota, Thredbo has free two hour mountain tours during July, August and early September. All you need is to be an upper intermediate skier or boarder and have a valid lift pass. Tours start at 11am daily, meet at the top of the Gunbarrel Express.

BACKCOUNTRY TOURS
Looking for a snow adventure with a difference? We have partnered with The North Face to offer Backcountry Tours. Take an out of resort trip into the side and backcountry of the spectacular Main Range. Strap on the snow shoes for a tour around the Ramshead Range or wander longer to the top of Mt Kosciuszko. Splitboarders and ski tourers, head high with the backcountry team and make your mark in the chutes and untracked faces of the range. It's a great way to escape the resort, take in fresh mountain air and enjoy uncrowded slopes (you may not see anyone all day), all with the company of a knowledgeable backcountry expert. Tours with the Thredbo Backcountry Guides include snow and safety awareness, avalanche safety, backcountry familiarisation, basic navigation and snow survival skills.

COMING 2020 NEW MERRITTS GONDOLA
Replacing the Merritts Chairlift in 2020, the Merritts Gondola will take guests from Valley Terminal, at the base of Thredbo, to the Cruiser Area in just six minutes. The gondola will include a mid-station close to the base of the High Noon trail allowing guests to alight to access Friday Flat or alternatively load to access the Cruiser Area or Valley Terminal.

Trail Signage - You'll find the trail signs shown in the trail map key at various places on the mountain, they are there for your safety and protection. Please take note of them and obey them, particularly the "Trail Closed" and "Area Boundary" signs.
Tobogganing - Tobogganing and snowblowing are not permitted in Thredbo.

KIDS, TEENS AND ADULT LESSONS

ONE DAY FRIDAY FLAT FIRST TIMER PACKAGE – \$99

If it is your first time on the snow, never ever been skiing or snowboarding before, this one day package will get you up and going. It includes a group lesson to brush up on the basics and then you can practice your skills on Friday Flat for the rest of the day using the Easy Does It Chairlift and three Snow Runners.



KIDS LESSONS

THREDBOLAND – Thredboland is one of the best children's ski programs in the country. The all day program is specifically designed to take children through the stages of skiing in a professional yet fun, safe and happy environment.

3–4 YEAR OLDS – MAX4
