Largest size features and jumps. Jump-on rails with gaps & narrow surfaces. Superpipe. Advanced and Experts only. Most difficult features.

Freestyle terrain may contain jumps, hits, ramps, embankments, fun boxes, jibs, rails, half pipes, quarter pipers, snowcross, freestyle bump terrain and other constructed or natural terrain features.

Do not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from abov

Before starting downhill or merging onto a trail, look uphill and yield to others.

If you are involved in or witness a collision or accident, you must remain at the scene and identify yourself to the Ski Patrol.

Always use proper devices to help provent runaway equipment.

Keep off closed trails and closed areas.

You must not use lifts or terrain if your ability is impaired through use of alcohol or drugs.

 You must have sufficient physical dexterity, ability and knowledge to safely load, ride and unload lifts. If in doubt, ask the lift attendant. on resort property.
